There are 24 bamboo resonators, also graduated in length, under the wood bars. Ropes for suspending the marimba are attached to

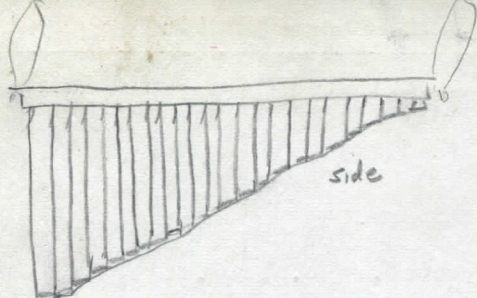

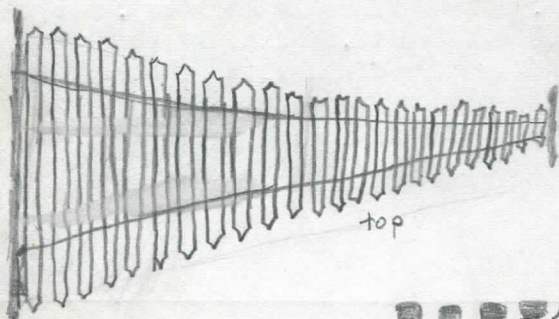
