**Description:** Top and short sleeves are of white flowered black cotton, trimmed <sup>AT NECK</sup> with red, yellow, blue, and pink, and sleeves with orange and grey. 2 rectangular panels sewn together form body. Side A design: 2 rows of 2 ovals—each oval connected by thin neck—in sets of two. The rows are separated by 3 irregular crosses and 2 T-shaped objects. A band of inverted and reversed L's appears at top. Empty spaces are filled in with rows of lines. Side B design: 3 rows of connected ovals. Rows are separated by (in cm.) Length: 69.5; width: 54.5.
