Ear ornements of shell are worn by both sexes, all of which are ornamented with incised designs. When ready fro use a string or brass-wire loop passes through the perforation at the center. The same loop hangs from the lobe of the ear, if worn by a man, or from the helix, if by a woman. The larger ones are usually worn by the women.
