A: 15 x 3 cm; main portion of cross is a solid, concave-sided diamond with conical points on left and right sides; top is hollow, pointed oval with a wing-like triangle on each side of the top point.

B: 14.5 x 3 cm; concave-sided diamond with conical points at left, right, and top.

D: 14 x 3; main part is solid, concave diamond with conical points on left and right corners; top is a hollow oval with flat, triangular points at left, right, and top.

F: 14 x 3; a hollow diamond shape with a horizontal bar across the center and conical points at the right and left corners, surmounted by a hollow, pointed oval with a winglike triangle projecting on either side of the top.
