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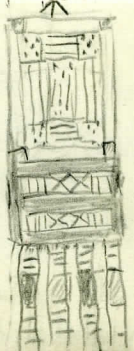
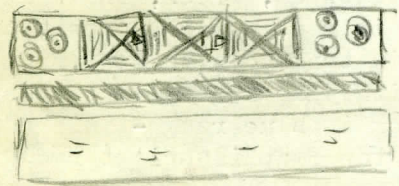
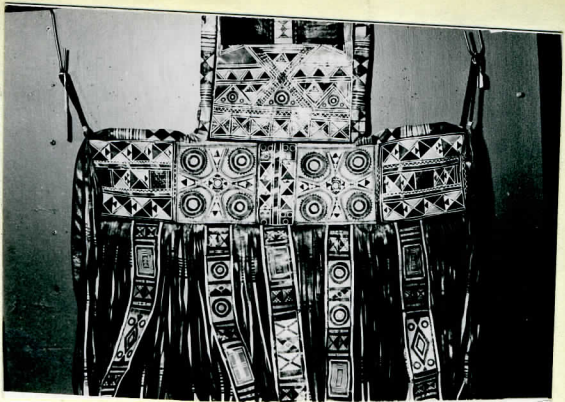
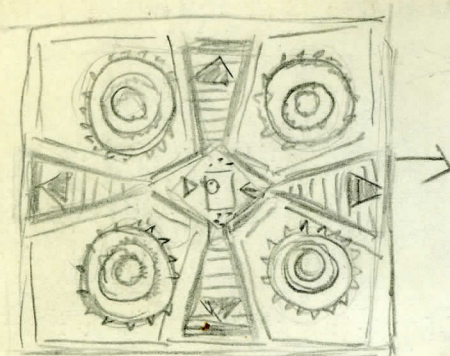
Description: The front is mainly yellow leather trimmed with geometric applique in black, green, and white leather and with embroidery in red, yellow, green, and blue cotton thread. The bag is trimmed with blue, yellow, and red leather fringe and with 5 appliqued leather straps ca. 45 cm. long. The back is blue rough-finished leather; the back of the top flap is bright red with black linear decoration.
