Description: Woman's stool is made of Kithwala wood and is only used in the house. In general men and women sit on their haunches or on the ground. Stool seat is a round cross-section of tree trunk, slightly concave and roughly 3.25 cm. thick. It is broken on one side. Three radiating slab legs 2.5 to 3 cm. thick are notches on the outside and rounded on the inside. Color dark brown from age.
