**Provenience:** Kenya**People or Culture:** Kamba Location Ngomeni**Object:** Hoop (ndia) 2 pr. sticks(malungusa)**Material:** Wood, fibre

**Description:** Mwange (or mukanga) wood bound into a hoop with wood fibre (muange chaoba) string. A line of boys stands each on his own spot. The one at the head of the line throws the hoop (A) and each boy in turn throws his sticks (B.C.) to stop the hoop. B. and C are made of two small sticks with twisted fibre string tied between. The boy who succeeds takes his turn at the head of the line.
