Description: Carved from the wood of the Mbamabara tree (*Commifera Africana*). Smooth bowl is rounded at the bottom and squared at the lip. A hole is burned in the side to hold a leather loop for hanging when not in use. A triple row of small round burned indentations (poker work) across the bottom and burning around the lip form decorations. Small version of 222198. Used only for eating.

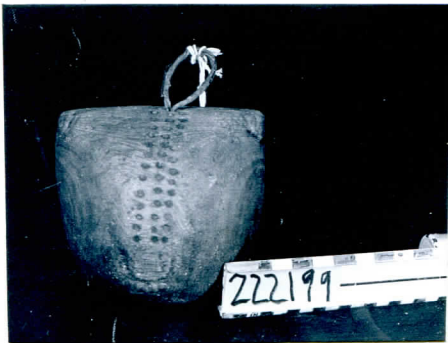
