Description: Made from a single piece of wood. It has a round hollow base and a thick, flat stand with concave sides. Propeller-shaped top has incurved sides and ends. A vertical rolled leather handle is knotted through two holes in the stand. Leather is bound top and bottom with copper wire. Mended with a patch of aluminum.
