Description: Natural colored sleeping mat has brown thread stitching in lengthwise rows approximately 3.75 cm. apart. One end is sewn over a wooden rod so that the mat may be hung. A green and pink geometric design of yarn is woven into the rushes at the rod end. Two metal hooks are attached to the rod.

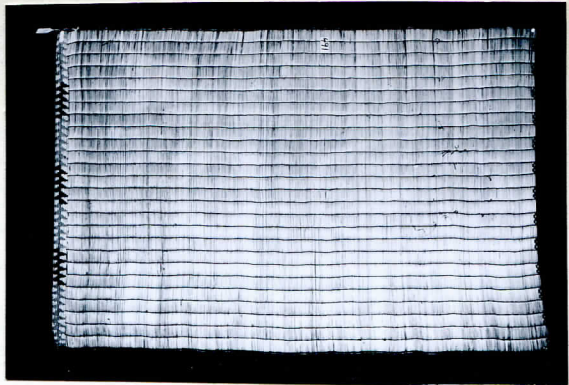
