Description: A (Mouthpiece and foreshaft): Rolled sheet of metal forming tube, flaring slightly and bent back to form rim at mouthpiece; strips of metal fasten the joining; keeled spheroidal swelling below end of shaft.

B (Further shaft and bell): Tube of same diam. as A; keeled spheroidal swelling at each end; bell begins to flare out gradually after the


