Provenience: Nigeria: Bokkos (about 40 mi. south of Jos)

People or Culture: Fulani (possibly Hausa manufacture)

Object: pressure drum and drumstick

Material: wood; leather

Description: (a) cylindrical shaft with bowl-shaped expansions at each end; leather drumhead stretched over one end and rolled over itself around edge; twisted leather thongs pass through perforations in the roll and are carried through perforations in the opposite bowl, thus making for tension upon the membrane (b) tapered stick curved distad, ending in flaring dilation.
