No foot covering is ordinarily worn but when traversing stony ground sandals are occasionally made to protect the feet. These are cut out from the leaf-stalk of the aeta palm, *Mauritia flexuosa*. A few hours' use wears them out but others are secured in a few minutes. They are always measured to fit the foot and worn with the cord passing between the great toe and the next.
