Description: mortar made up of two truncate conical forms joined at their narrower ends; the bowl is higher than the base and curves and flares out somewhat toward its mouth; the edge of the mouth is scalloped. pestle is a brass shaft widening toward the pounding end, which is flat; there is a keeled knob at the center of the shaft and below the narrow end.
