The influence is shown in the jacket of this outfit (129399) Blue cotton cloth has been used as the foundation and on the shoulders is a little embroidery, but of a very inferior type, while the final decoration is added by attaching several hundred disk shells. The typical skirts used by the Bile-an women are like this specimen, with little or no decoration aside from a panel made up of a few lighter parallel bands.
