**Description:** Length-wise brown (color made from mud mixed with copper) stripes; rust red (from the NARA tree) stripes; mustard (NARA mixed with tumeric) stripes, which have ikat inwoven stylized men in white single stylized leaves & paired leaves. Cloth is woven in 2 panels (43.5 cm. each), joined in middle with black thread, weft is black. Hemmed at 2 ends with black thread, 2 outside edges are selvaged. Mid 20th century. Owner-Kittayan Nitapak.
