Description: Red(color made from NARA tree) stripes; green (NARA with copper added) stripes; blue stripes, which have ikat inwoven stylized men in white with extended arms. Interspersed with pairs of white stylized leaves, and jagged white lines. Cloth is woven in 2 panels (35.5 cm. each) joined in middle with blue thread, weft is navy. Hemmed at 2 ends with blue thread, 2 outside edges are selvaged. Mid. 20th Cen. Owner=Kittayan Nitapak.

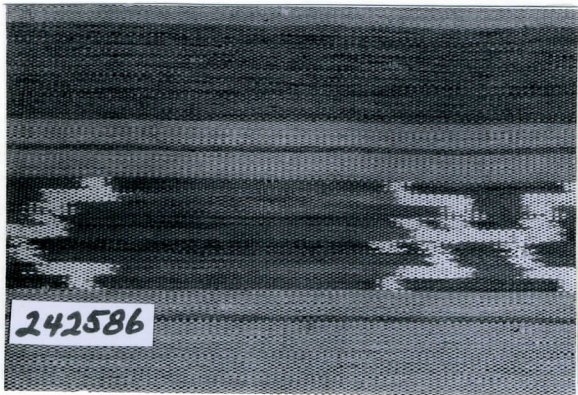
