Pair of cuffs of thin silver, made to open and to hinge on a pin and socket arrangement. They are plain inside but richly ornamented with incised geometrical designs on the outside. The principal ornament is a pear-shaped red stone 4 cms. long, inset in the front of each cuff. In the middle of the red stone is a silver star.
