Triangle of embossed silver decorated with enamel bosses of yellow and pink concentric design outlined with rope cording on a green background--3 small bosses in a triangular placement around 1 larger boss, connected by geometric lines and pierced work. Lower end has a flat loop ending in a raised square of red glass. Each outer side has protruding layered rectangles. Upper end extends into a spear-like embossed point, decorated
