Description: 7 embossed hinged shield-shaped panels decorated in embossed floral design centered with cone ending in a loop from which hangs a ring linked to a coin, base of panels have 3 such coin attachments. Top of middle panel and sides of each end panel have similar attachment to a chain to a ring to a circular ornament with a dome in the center, 2 conifer shaped extensions - one ending in a loop, the other in a hook,

these 3 are then hooked together to fit the head. The 27 silver 2½ dirhams coins have a 6 pointed star on the reverse with the obverse carrying dates from AH 1299 to AH 1329, covering the reigns of Hasan I (1873-1894) and ABD AL - AZAZ (1894-1908).
