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In cold weather men wear a sleeveless shirt or poncho. This is not woven of wool but of caraguata fiber as are the bags, nets and hammocks, and is not made on a loom. It is netted in a single long piece with a neck slit in the center, and the sides are then sewn together. A slight attempt at decoration is made with colored strands and one specimen has further been elaborately decorated with feathers and snake rattles to both front and back, probably for use in a dance.
