Round bottom baskets of open wickerwork are known as quakes and are used for carrying general burdens, storing provisions as cages for tame animals and many other varied uses. Most of these are coarsely and quickly made, some far more coarsely than others. The coarsest are made of unsplit twigs, the majority of splints of the iturite, the common basket material.
