Description: Hollow wooden core is covered with wide strips of cow-hide with hair, shaped and stretched while wet. A narrow leather sling is threaded through flaps cut in the hide and holds a leather cap.. It is used for hunting though illegal at this time. Dark brown and worn with age. Most of the hair is gone.
