Description: Shaft of woody grass with nodes. Wooden foreshaft with gum and string bound metal tip and barb (nail), inserted in shaft wrapped in dark brown fiber. Nock cut in shaft and bound with string. Straight feathering, a black and a yellow-blue attached with string (some of which green and wraps 2 small red Dimensions: feathers against the shaft.) Beyond (in cm.) feathering shaft is wrapped in brown fiber. Made by men. Sketch reverse.
