Such clothing i.e. red should only be worn by a mabotot - a man who has killed five or more persons. When he has killed twenty he is known as maisteg & then can wear a complete black suit. (Black ~~suits~~ coats, embroidered) are worn by men not maisteg, but they never wear a complete black suit.

A person who wears the clothing or ornaments to which he is not entitled will soon become sick and will die.

The flower tala-banay (cresta-de-gallo) is also worn by the successful warriors.
