## INSCRIPTION

Author statement Li Shih-yung 李時榮撰

Description of content The headstone bears eight characters in regular style as indicated in above title. The text reports that the mosque was established in the first year of Tien-pao of T'ang dynasty (A.D. 742) 唐天寶元年 and was successively restored in 1127, Sung dynasty, Ching-k'an 2nd year 宋靖康二年; 1265, Yuan dynasty, Chih-yüan 2nd year 元至元二年; 1315, Yuan dynasty, Yen-yü 2nd year 元延祐二年; 1482, Ming dynasty, Cheng-hua 18th year 明成化十八年. The present restoration was begun in Chia-ching, first year (1522) 嘉靖元年, and was finished in 1526. The stone tablet was erected for this occasion.
