1856	<p data-bbox="343 246 800 292">People: Angel people</p> <p data-bbox="343 298 1178 343">Object: Armband with rattle (<i>saosao atung</i>)</p> <p data-bbox="343 350 1424 395">Material: barkcloth, seeds, beads, fiber rope, fragrant leaves</p> <p data-bbox="343 401 1484 702">Description: Armband made of barkcloth, or tapa (<i>mal</i>), with a rattle made of seeds; also with beads (<i>rareng</i>), rope (<i>mai anao</i>), and fragrant leaves (<i>yong</i>). Strip of tapa has two rattles. Each rattle consists of beaded strands that end in 3 seeds of the (<i>saosao</i>) tree (<i>saosao atung</i>). All the seeds are open at the bottom, and some have strands of purple and/or green fiber hanging from it.</p>
