Slots at top and bottom for bolt, slot at top for key. Bow shape design incised on front. Mechanism has 3 tumblers and 2 pins fitting into 3 notches. B-wood bolt with mushroom shaped top and 3 notches on each side for engaging tumblers. C-wrought iron key has 'C' curved handle and 3 teeth for disengaging tumblers. (over)
