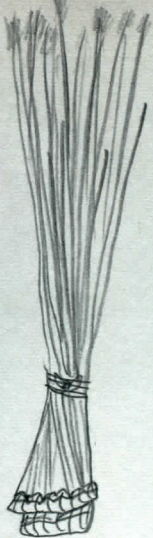
Description: Broom formed from a length of fringe made of a straw-like fiber which has been rolled up and tied near the top. Made by men mostly for women. Sketch reverse side.

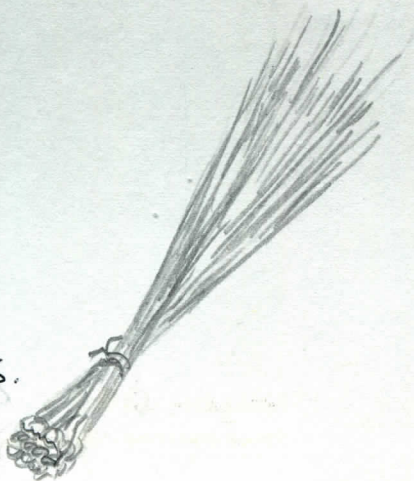
