Object: Arrow for hunting paca and other large animals.

Material: Bamboo, chonta, woody grass, corn husk, string and paint.

Description: Beige woody grass shaft, chonta foreshaft and bamboo point. Relatively long point is barbed on the lower half (8 barbs on one side, 12 on other). It is covered with a clear "lacquer" and is daubed on the barbs and near the top with black paint. Fore-shaft attached to shaft and point with a corn husk and string wrapping. Butt end of arrow wrapped with string. Sketch reverse side.
