Description: Woody grass shaft, longer ~~chonta~~ foreshaft and a carved tapir bone point forming a tip and single barb affixed with string wrapping and black gum.

Where foreshaft fitted into shaft is a wrapping of corn husk and string. Butt end of shaft wrapped with string. Sketch reverse side.
