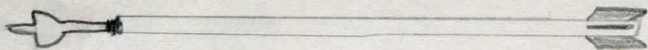
Description: ^{gum} Foreshaft and tip carved from single piece of wood; point consists of cone-shaped wedge with a blunt rod protruding from base. Foreshaft is inserted into the hollowed end of the woody grass and secured with gummed cotton string. Nock end is feathered with a pair of split black feathers in slight spiral, secured with gummed cotton string.
