Material: Chonta palm, paint, thread, corn husk

Description: Relatively flat length of chonta tapered to a point at both ends. Spearhead, central part one side, painted black. Whole spear covered with a reddish to clear "lacquer". Off-center toward narrower portion of spear is a corn husk wrapping held on with white thread, probably a grip. Sketch reverse side.
