Description: Length of chonta, flat on one face slightly convex on the other, tapered to a point at both ends. Off-center, at base of spearhead, toward narrower portion of spear is a grip, corn husk wrapping held on with string. Per collector the spear is unpainted because of a shortage of paint in camp.
