The total effect is of equal amounts of blue and white. A scalloped line of "cowie eyes" two c.m. in diameter are arranged across each border. Damask has a floral pattern and is pieced to lappa size. Unhemmed.

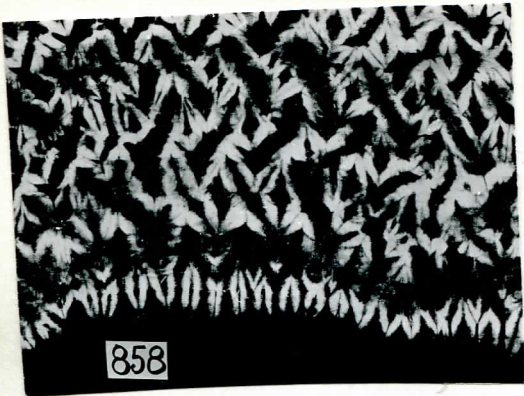
