Material: Chonta palm, cotton cloth & threads, gum

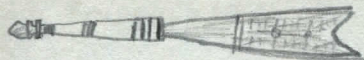
Description: Club made off chonta palm, *incised* with geometric design. Paddle end has thick center tapering off to blade-like edges, with V wedge carved out of tip. The other end tapers off to an oval grip, wrapped with white cotton sewn in place and decorated with three groups of multicolored cotton rings which are in turn held in place by cotton fibers finished with black gum. A loop of woven cotton suspends from the middle cotton ring. (Sketch at back)
