Material: Painted wood, woody grass, cotton string

Description: Paddle-shaped club carved from hard wood, painted black, incised with geometric designs. Paddle end has thick center tapering off to blade-like edges with V wedge carved out of tip. The other end tapers to an oval grip, wrapped with flat strips of woody grass held in place by seven rings of black, red and green cotton threads tightly wound around the strips. A woven cotton loop handle is attached to one of the cotton rings. Per collector, "Bad sample".
