Material: Painted wood, cotton cloth and string

Description: Paddle-shaped club carved from hard wood, painted black, incised with geometric designs. Paddle/^{end} has thick center tapering off to blade-like edges with V wedge carved out of tip. The other end tapers to an oval-grip, wrapped with a piece of white cotton cloth, sewn in place and decorated with three groups of multicolored cotton strips, in turn secured tightly by multicolored cotton strings.
