INSCRIPTION

Author statement *I-shan*Description of content Poem referring to the flowering plum which stand first among the flowers. It was written by I-shan *夷山* and carries two of his own seals.The present rubbing was taken from a stone cut by Chao Shang-tē, native of Ch'ang-an *長安趙尚德*. No date is given. The original picture from the stone bears the name of Su Shih *蘇軾* with a seal bearing the name of *Su Tung-po 蘇東坡*, his courtesy name.
