Description of content Hall plans in the Confucius Temple in Hsi-an. In the center of the hall, appearing at the top of the rubbing are eight characters designating the tablet to Confucius, and on either side, and in the hall plans below are the characters designating the tablets of his disciples. The tablets are arranged in order, each one bearing the name of a disciple. At the bottom of the room, as shown on the rubbing, is an inscription written by Sun Nêng-k'uan 孫能寬 which reports that the stone tablet was erected by a number of officials of Hsi-an, and gives the names of those who contributed to the erection of the tablet.
