TITLE [Chiao-shan hsien-sheng ming-yü chien-shih 叔山先生名語鑄石] (a famous saying by the Honorable Chiao-shan cut into stone)

INSCRIPTION

Author statement

Description of content The Honorable Chiao-shan 叔山 was the courtesy name of Yang Chi-shêng 楊繼盛 (A.D. 1516-1556), a loyal high official of the Ming period. He was cannonized as Chung-min 忠愍. The present rubbing was taken from a stone inscription of a famous saying of Yan Chi-shêng's which appears in the center of the rubbing in two columns of large characters in square style: "He who serves in an official position for the nation, must in substance be honest, sincere and upright in conduct". The quotation is accompanied on the right of the rubbing by a eulogy to Yang by Li Tu.† On the left is a note of admiration to Yang by the calligrapher, Lan Yu-t'ang. Both notes are in correspondence style.
