Author statement

Description of content Two large characters horizontally written by a prince of the Ming dynasty who was named Chuang-hsi 莊僖. He resided in the feudatory state of Yung-shou, Shensi Province. Above the calligraphy is an official seal of the Prince of Yung-shou 永壽. The stone was erected by a descendant and heir of the Prince of Yung-shou.
