Description of content The headstone inscription is in seal style as indicated in above title.

The Shou-ti 首題 (head title) bears eleven characters as: Ta t'ang ku Wei-chün Shao Jun-chih lei pien hsü 大唐故魏郡邵潤之誄 (eulogy to Shao Jun-chih, native of Wei-chün under T'ang dynasty).

The eulogy was written by Hsu Ch'iao, father-in-law of the deceased. The text is in two parts, with the preface in prose, and the eulogy in four character rhyme.
