INSCRIPTION

Author statement

Huang Yang 黃羊記

Description of content This stone tablet eulogy was erected to Mēng Hsiao-chü. At the end of the text of the rubbing is a foot-note in regular style by Hsieh Ch'ung-chi 謝崇基 dated Kuang-hsu, 27th year (A.D. 1901) which states that the stone was rediscovered in the 9th lunar month of this same year in the south of Chao-t'ung-hsiang. The exact date is not given, but based upon the square style of the calligraphy, Hsieh recognizes that the inscription may have been made sometime between the Han and Wei dynasties. The stone was transported to Feng-chih Shu-yüan 鳳池書院
