and eyebrows painted in. Circle of black dots outline

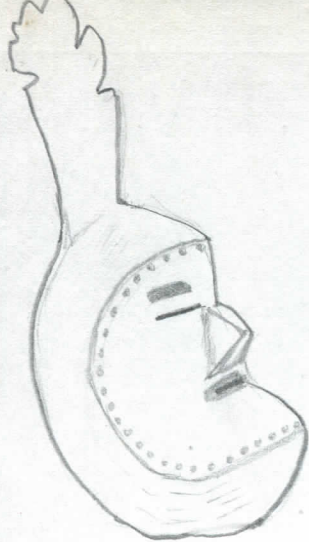
