These balls of red coloring matter are used principally for a painting the body, less frequently for painting other objects. It is prepared from the leaves of the yellow-flowered bignomia, chica, with some less-important ingredients. The dry leaves are boiled over a fire and some other bark and twig elements are added. After boiling for some time the sediment is allowed to cake and is rolled into the balls.
