Description of content Rubbing inscription from a large square bronze seal with six characters in pictographic style. The seal is cast in two halves, surmounted by figure of an animal (tiger), hence used for military purpose. The characters are engraved in the ancient square writing of the Mongols, the Paggi-pa writing.
