Suspended from lower end of each cloth strip are 3 red feathers adorned with smaller feathers and down in turquoise, purple, black and white. At center of the collar is a fluted bone, possibly of deer, as a pendant. Fastened with plant fibre twine. Acc. collector, made by men for men's use only; ceremonial
