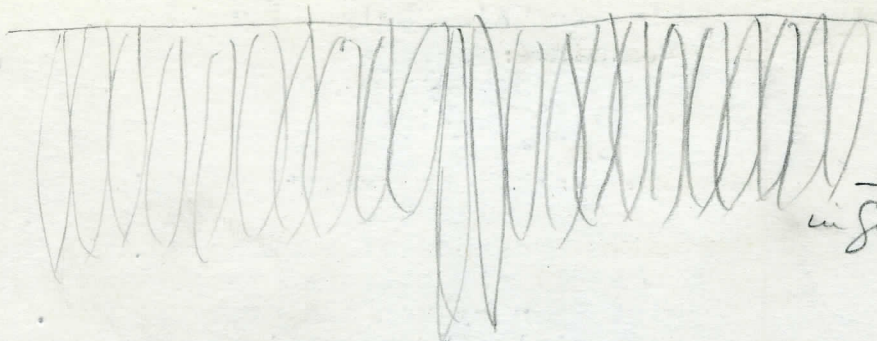
Description: Feather of blue macaw, jabiru
