Description: Tubular bowl carved from one piece of heavy wood; tapers to kind of stem at bottom. Mouthpiece, a length of hollow bone, inserted at side midway. Bowl not hollowed to where mouthpiece inserted. Tabs at rim of bowl and bottom of "stem". Geometric designs scratched all over painted black surface. Sketch reverse side.
